With a commitment to serving her clients, Suzette stresses the importance of “attractive design at a reasonable price.”

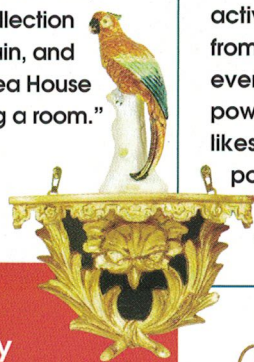


ELEGANZA
